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Why become a Sponsor and give a chance to a child with Fondation Kana?

Sponsoring a child according to Fondation Kana's philosophy is;

- Engaging in a solidarity spirit.
- Helping a child or adolescent to grow.
- Share privileged moments together.
- Create a tie between a child and family.
- Give a future to a child.

Nutrition, Medical treatment, Education

10% of the amount that you give remains at the Fondation to cover her expenses in functioning. Fondation Kana insists on the possibility of interrupting sponsorship at any time. The simplest thing to do is contract for at least one year.

The amount destined to your godchild will permit he/she to be fed, treated and sent to school. Our system of sponsorship privileges development actions at long-term.

At this rate Education is top priority.

When a relationship is engaged

Every sponsor knows the name face and living conditions of her godchild. Fondation Kana permits you to follow up the progress and come in contact with the child through correspondence. The type of relationship is definitely not necessary.

“If one does not know his/her godchild in flesh and blood, we find letters to be artificial and repetitive. How can one be surprised at this? The child does not know the sponsor. But a more tangible bond can be

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established if you decide to visit your godchild in his/her country (which is an opportunity not given to all).

Delicate to handle meanwhile, the fact that reports are mediatized through money makes it one of our duties to explain to the children and to the families that the assistance is strictly for education and for sponsoring since “the godchildren usually think their sponsors are some rich godfathers and godmothers. Another thing noticed is “the children are quite sad when their sponsors do not ever send letters. It is not an anonymous humanitarian action.

One has to know into what one gets involved in not to feel trapped later. When a sponsor quits, Fondation Kana immediately looks for someone to replace that godchild’s sponsor. And if it is not possible to meet your godchild, at least you would have permitted that child to grow in acceptable conditions...

Direct relationships, the best guarantee for Fondation Kana

Fondation Kana is a member of the Verification Committee and Perception, in what concerns the enhancement structures for Orphans and Vulnerable Children (OVC) put in place by the Ministry of Social Affairs and her slogan is “give to a child his youth”. To be accepted, you must satisfy certain conditions: Financial transparency, loyalty of messages sent out during fund collection, utilizing it in line with announced objectives in accordance with statutes and loss of interest in management. But concerning sponsorship, the funders can by themselves connect with their godchild which is the best guarantee for success.

At Fondation Kana, amounts of money allocated to godchildren are subjected to strict control as per invoices justifying the spending on the children.

Why become a Sponsor?

Many children and the youth in Cameroon and in other poor countries live difficult family, education, social, and economic situations which affect what they become.

Sponsorship represents the only opportunity for them to build the right future, thanks to the connections and solidarity that can be built around

them and their families. Thanks to a godfather or godmother, these children and the youth will be guided and their parents will feel supported to well prepare for their futures.

To be a godfather or godmother (sponsor):

- You are engaging in a spirit of solidarity while building a long lasting relationship with a child or youth.
- You help such to grow by giving your emotional and educative help.
- You share with them happy moments; enriching your life as well as theirs.
- You create a real bond with the child and family. It is a source of joy.
- You give them the opportunity to build a future of their own.
